

Ukrainian Delegation Participates in the 32nd Session of the Congress

Ukrainian delegation started its work in the 32nd session of the Congress of Local and Regional Authorities of the Council of Europe.

32nd Session of the Congress started on March 28. Agenda of the Session includes the following issues: migration, Eastern-Mediterranean partnership, human rights situation on the local and regional level, challenges and achievements of European Local Self-governance implementation.

Ukrainian delegation will participate in the debates with Secretary General T. Jagland, Council of Europe Commissioner for Human Rights Nils Muižnieks, the Chair of the Committee of Ministers of the Council of Europe and Minister for Foreign Affairs Ioannis Kasoulides. Key points of the discussion during the debates with abovementioned officials are the following: issue of internally displaced persons in Ukraine, protection of rights and freedoms at the occupied territories of Crimea and Donbas, other important issues of the agenda.

Other meetings with the senior officials of the Organization within the framework pf the Session will cover future initiatives of Ukraine and perspectives of initiation of activities of our State in projects of the Council of Europe cooperation.
